Notice to Engineering Consultants

Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

The City of George is requesting Statements of Qualifications and performance information from qualified firms interested in providing professional engineering consulting services for the 2026—2028 calendar years in conjunction with City sponsored projects with the potential for funding in part through the State of Washington Community Development Block Grant Program with Federal funds provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, USDA—Rural Development, and Environmental Protection Agency. Other sources of funding may include Drinking Water State Revolving Funds, Department of Ecology, Public Works Board, WSDOT, Transportation Improvement Board and State and Federal appropriations. A number of state and federal equal opportunity and affirmative action requirements will apply to the selection process and throughout the project(s).

Required design services may include but are not limited to storm water management facilities, water systems, sewer systems, roadway and transportation projects, surveying, project management, and funding procurement. Firms desiring consideration shall submit three copies of a complete qualification package, limited to 20 single sided pages, for evaluating the firms qualifications.

The criteria categories used in the selection process, weighted as indicated, will include: Qualification of key personnel (20); Relevant experience as demonstrated on previous projects (30); Previous performance and familiarity with the City (30) and Experience with funding agencies (20).
